President's Corner

I had the privilege of addressing you back in the Spring of 2015 during my prior tenure as President of the SCS Board of Directors. As I reflect on my message then, I am encouraged by the resilience of the SCS staff and volunteers who have continued to demonstrate our agency's mission.

In Fall 2014, the Board decided to develop a long-range strategic plan, going into 2020, to determine the needs of our clients and the agency. That plan focused on three primary areas: advocacy, operational excellence, and organizational sustainability. While no one could have foreseen the health crisis that erupted in March 2020, we focused on ensuring that SCS was prepared to meet the needs of its clients effectively and efficiently, including improving client programs and the ability of the 725 Kifer Road facility to serve those clients.

Five years ago, SCS had just helped over 1,500 low-income Sunnyvale families in the annual Holiday Center. Fast forward to 2020, and we anticipate serving 2,500 low-income households this November and December. This is over a 65% increase in households from the previous year. Although we won't be able to allow families to "shop" in our Holiday Center this year, we still will provide nutritious food and gifts for



4,500 children, adults, and seniors.

It's clear that the economic effects of COVID-19 will continue to impact SCS clients well into next year. The longer these economic conditions exist, the more likely more of our families could be faced with eviction and homelessness. Your continued financial support throughout this crisis will be critical to our ability to help these families remain properly housed and fed for as long as it takes.

ability to package and delivery food to our growing list of homebound clients.

When the shelter-in-place order took effect on March 17, the City of Sunnyvale sent volunteers to help SCS. We immediately put City staff in our front lobby to help answer phones, manage paperwork, and speak with clients through our pandemic-inspired outdoor intercom system. We created socially distanced office space in our conference room for four City staff to help call hundreds of clients who had pending applications for assistance. Meanwhile, a caravan of City employees picked up food from SCS to sort and bag at their homes. Then those groceries were collected and given to City employees driving City automobiles to deliver the food to both our usual 135 homebound and disabled clients as well as 115 seniors who were unable to receive food previously provided by countyfunded programs.

We are extremely grateful for all of the City of Sunnyvale employees who stood with us and pitched in wherever needed to keep us afloat when COVID-19 forced unanticipated changes to our financial assistance and food-delivery programs.
