Under general supervision of the Food and Nutrition Program Manager, the Food and Nutrition Services Coordinator performs a variety of duties within the Food and Nutrition Department to achieve high standards of performance. This position is Full Time, Non-Exempt

SALARY RANGE: \$50K-\$58K, based on experience

DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- Assist in the development and implementation of program policy and procedure.
- Establish effective outreach strategies to ensure populations with greatest need connect with appropriate programs.
- Support Food Program referral and intake process.
- Coordinate with staff to conduct ongoing monitoring of clients to determine eligibility for services.
- Monitor program activity on regular basis to ensure timely deliveries and accommodate needed changes for efficiency.
- Collaborate with Food and Nutrition staff to procure inventory needed for food programs.
- Collaborate with community volunteers to facilitate program outcomes
- Perform clerical tasks related to food programs, to include, but not limited to reports, correspondence, flyers, and forms.
- Conduct community outreach to recruit and enroll new program participants
- Conduct ongoing program evaluations to improve programming and client experience
- Present information regarding food programs to diverse groups
- Identify and work with partner organizations to create sustainable food programming to support the community.
- Works with leadership team to analyze program data and identify opportunities to improve systems and processes.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

- Education in social work administration, public health, or a related field and/or at least 3 years of experience working with low-income communities in a nonprofit setting.
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills, including the ability to clearly explain complex topics and translate into educational materials
- Strong critical thinking and decision-making skills.
- Solid time management skills; ability to work independently and maintain a high level of accountability and initiative.
- Must possess strong mathematical skills, including experience calculating weights and measures.
- Computer proficiency required.
- Access to reliable insured transportation.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

The physical requirements for this position are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job.

- Must be able to frequently walk, stand and sit for extended time periods.
- Repetitive use of hands; reaching and turning;
- Ability to lift up to 50 pounds; light lifting of supplies and materials;
- Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision and the ability to adjust focus.
- Must be able to twist, turn, kneel, bend and stoop.
